






# Mitacs a national independant non-profit organization supporting collaborative innovation.





Applied research collaborations between researchers & Canadian and international companies and not-for-profit organizations




Open to academic institutions across the country

# Mitacs Accelerate

**Quick**, simple application process


Applications evaluated by external experts

Decision within **6-8 weeks**



# Mitacs Accelerate



A researcher spends a minimum of 4 to 6 months—  
or **one module**—on a project.



You can have as many  
modules as you need.





The researcher spends a minimum

# Mitacs Accelerate

Candidates can do multiple 4- to 6-month modules

- Master's up to **24 months**
- PhD's up to **48 months**
- Postdocs up to **36 months**


Building a network of international accelerators and incubators
