Riding properly knowing the personal transport method!

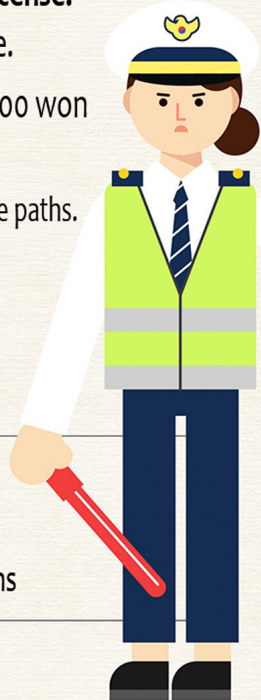
- ① Requires a motor license or small-sized vehicles license.
Penalties of up to 300,000 won for unlicensed use.
- ② **Must wear a safety helmet**, you will be fined 20,000 won if you are caught not wearing it.
- ③ Road Traffic Act prohibits driving on sidewalks and bicycle paths.
Drive on the road
limit the maximum speed to less than 25 km/h.

※ As a pilot project in some areas, it may be permitted to drive on bike paths or in parks. In principle, no driving is possible.

Enhanced Safety Standards(Effective February 2020)

- Electric board maximum weight limit of 30 kg
- Mandatory installation of headlamps, taillights and horns

Never drink or drive. Same punishment as car.



Personal Transport(PM) Traffic Safety Rules

01. Definite Basic Inspection Before Driving

- Check brakes, handles, tire pressures, batteries, etc.
- Watch out for fire hazard caused by explosion when charging with shock or overcharging

02. Safe driving habits/Requires sufficient practice in a safe place before driving

- Prohibits sudden operation (direction, acceleration, deceleration)
- On the crosswalk, pull down and cross.
- Drive at night with the lights on and the rear lights on.
- Refrain from driving in the event of bad weather such as rain.
- Do not use earphones or cell phones while driving
- Wear safety gear such as helmet, gloves, wrist guards, knee and elbow pads.



In the event of a number of people not complying with safety regulations or a serious accident, the kickboard will be restricted from entering the school, so please follow the relevant laws and safety regulations.
