Riding properly knowing the personal transport method!

- ① Requires a motor **license** or small-sized vehicles **license**. Penalties of up to 300,000 won for unlicensed use.
- ② **Must wear a safety helmet**, you will be fined 20,000 won if you are caught not wearing it.
- ③ Road Traffic Act prohibits driving on sidewalks and bicycle paths.
 Drive on the road
 limit the maximum speed to less than 25 km/h.

*As a pilot project in some areas, it may be permitted to drive on bike paths or in parks. In principle, no driving is possible.

Enhanced Safety Standards(Effective February 2020)

- Electric board maximum weight limit of 30 kg
- Mandatory installation of headlamps, taillights and horns

Never drink or drive. Same punishment as car.


